These Special Sessions will be organised at the AIIT 2nd International Congress TIS ROMA 2019 *Transport Infrastructure and Systems in a Changing World* in collaboration with the Italian Association for Traffic and Transport Engineering (AIIT), at the Automobile Club d'Italia Headquarters in Rome.  
23-24 September 2019

This Call for Abstracts aims to attract WCTR members to present their work related to the following topics relevant to SIG G3 objectives:

- Good practice on urban transport planning and policy
- Evaluation methods for transport planning and policy
- Sustainable urban mobility plans
- Wider policy impacts of future urban transport systems
- Stakeholder engagement processes in transport planning and policy
- Scenario analysis and policy packaging toward sustainable mobility

Abstracts should be up to 300 words long with at least 3 keywords. Deadline for the submission of abstract is **12th February 2019**. Upon acceptance a full paper will be required by the **12th April 2019**. Accepted papers will be considered for a special issue of the Journal Research in Transportation Business and Management or be published in the dedicated Transportation Research Procedia (Elsevier) coordinated by the Congress.
